Before playing the game, print enough answer sheets for all of your students. You will find that page at the END of the file on the last slide.

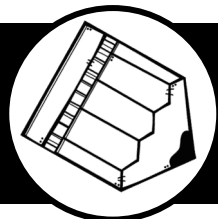

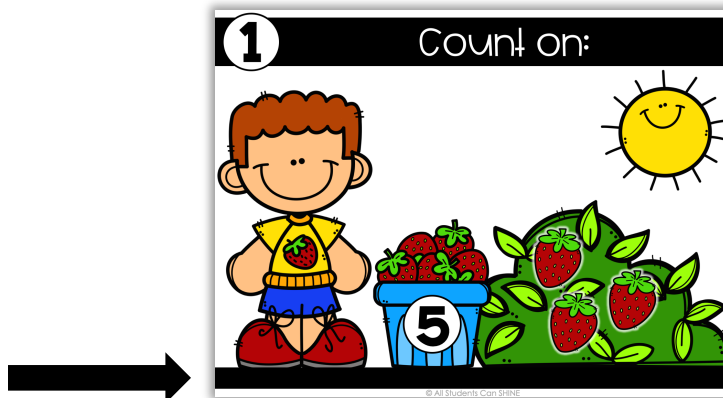


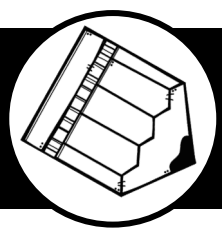
Instructions:
