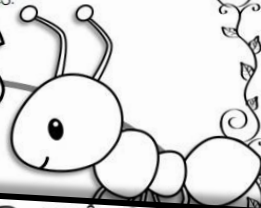


COMPARING INSECTS

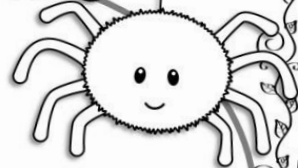

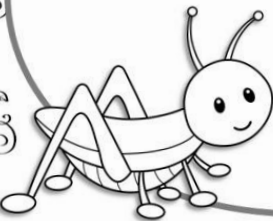

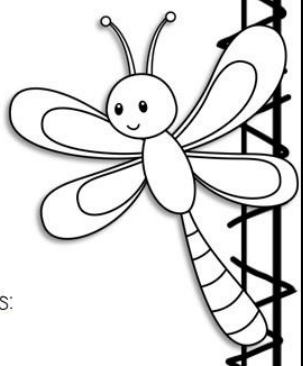

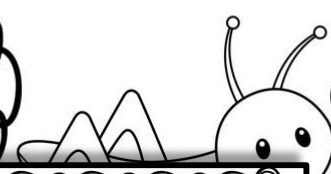

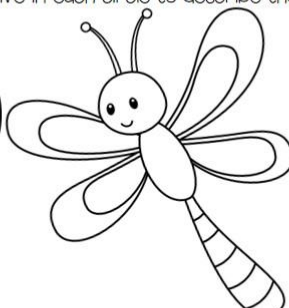

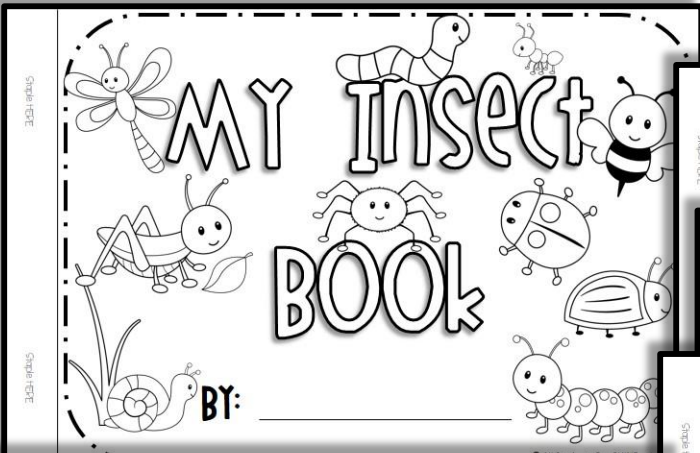
