RAIN Experiment



What you will need:

- A clear jar or cup
- Water
- Food coloring
- Eye dropper
- Shaving cream



Fill the cup with water (about $\frac{3}{4}$ full).
Put shaving cream on top.
Use the eye dropper to drop food coloring on top of the shaving cream.
Watch the rain happen!

Explain to your students that as clouds (shaving cream) get too full with water, it starts to rain.

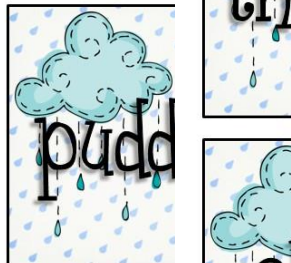
