Note TO THE TEACHER

There are two templates for every flipbook. The first has lines on the bottom and a box at the top where your students can illustrate their writing.

The second template has more lines and no box. Use this format for students who tend to write more than others. They can always illustrate their writing on the back of each page if they wish to do so.

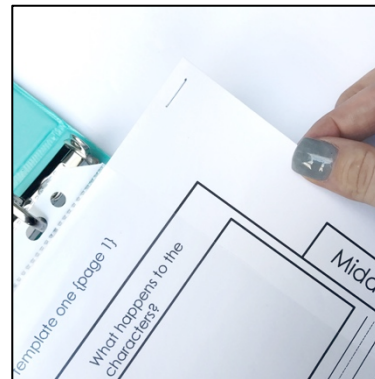
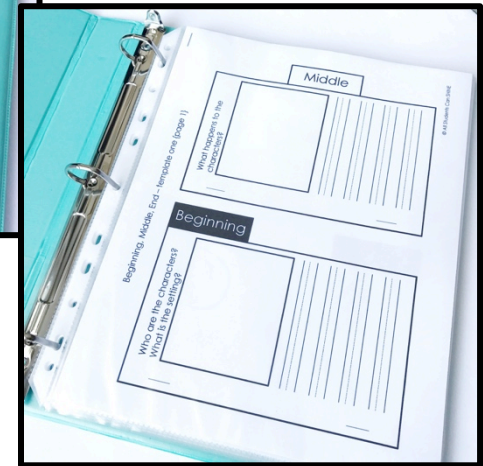
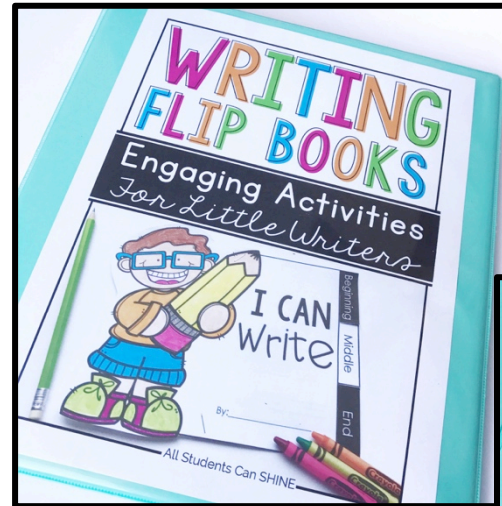

INSTRUCTIONS

Keep pages for each flipbook in plastic sleeves in a binder. Students can choose which flipbook they want to work on. I always have them work on their writing FIRST and cutting second. This way, they don't have scrap papers on their desks until the end of the writing period. When all of the pages are completed and cut, I staple them together to make a book.



Tip: Staple the pages that go together. This way, your students will know exactly how many pages they need for the flipbook that they choose.

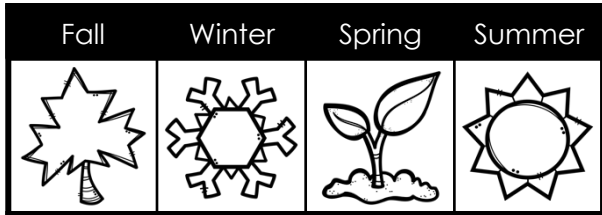

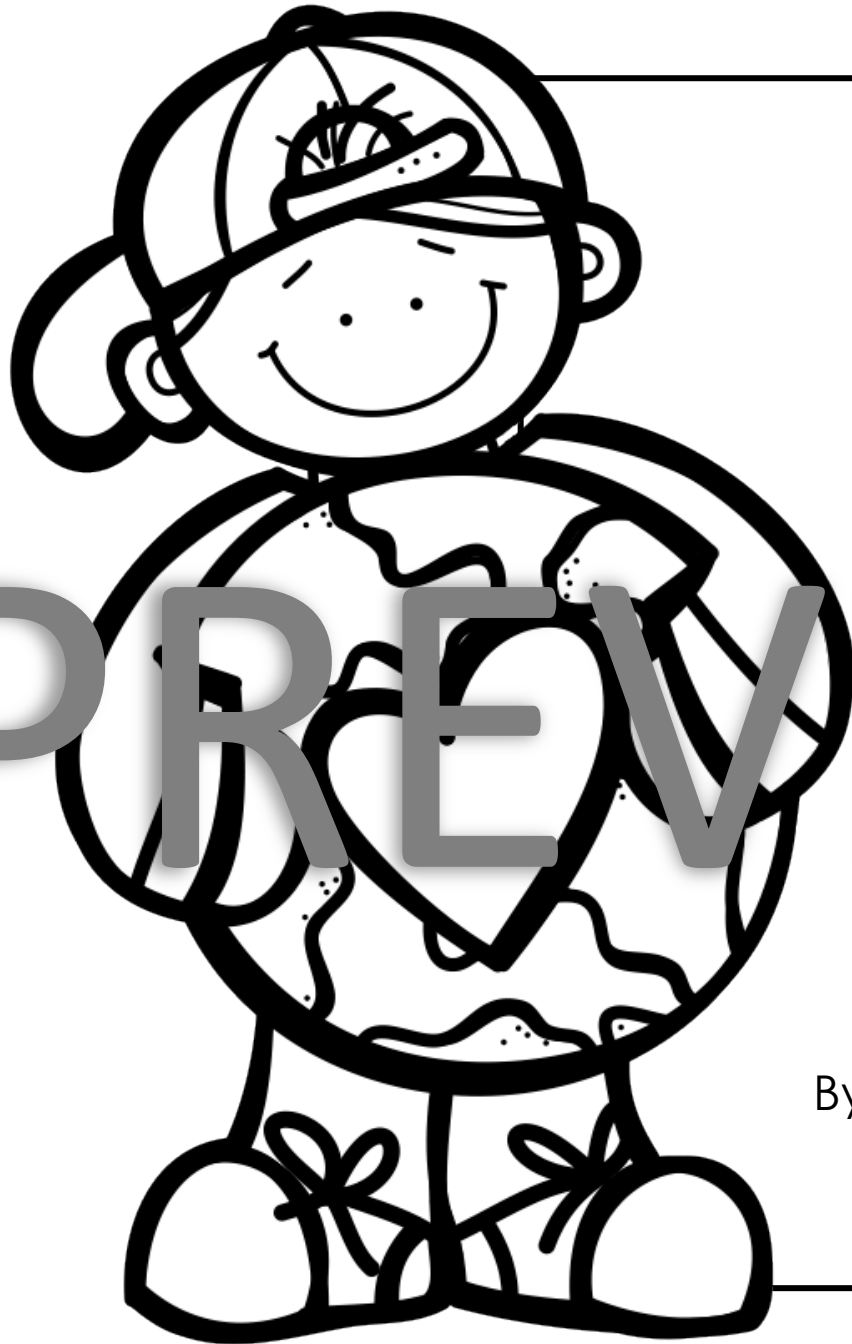
