# LIBRARY PRINTING:

## BOOK STICKERS

- Option 1: Print the labels on Avery Presta 94103 or 69993 (1" x 1" labels) or equivalent size labels. Print "actual size," not fit to page.
- Option 2: Print on full-sheet sticker paper and cut out if you don't have pre-cut labels.
- Option 3: Print the labels on regular paper or cardstock, then use tape to secure them on the books.

## BOOK BIN LABELS

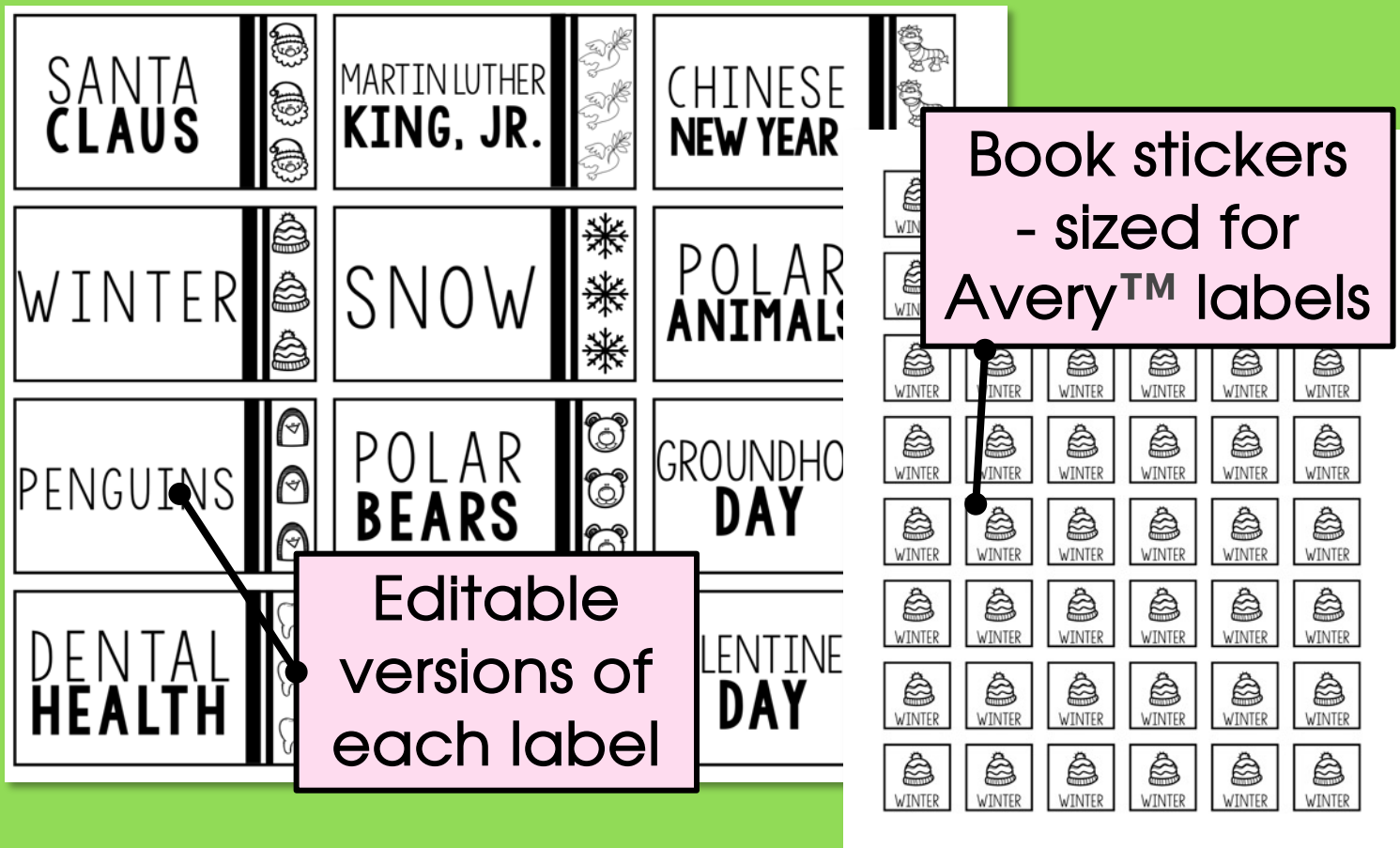
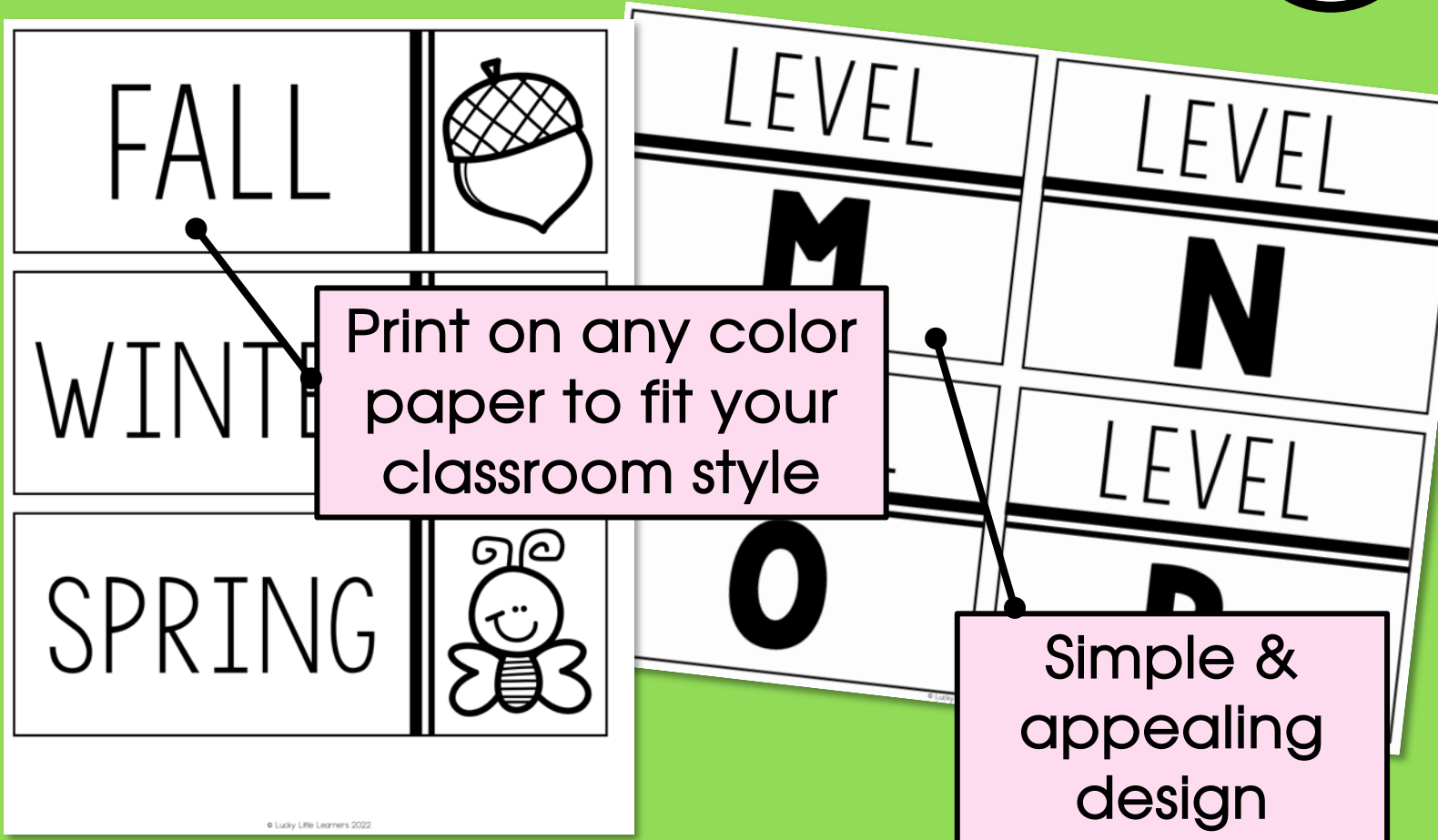
- Measure the size of your book bins where you want to put the labels. Select which size of labels that will fit your bins the best.
- When printing, choose "actual size" on the printing options for it to be precise measurements.
- If your bins do not fit with any of the 3 book bin label sizes, you can use the "Scale" feature on the printing settings to shrink or enlarge any of the labels when printing.

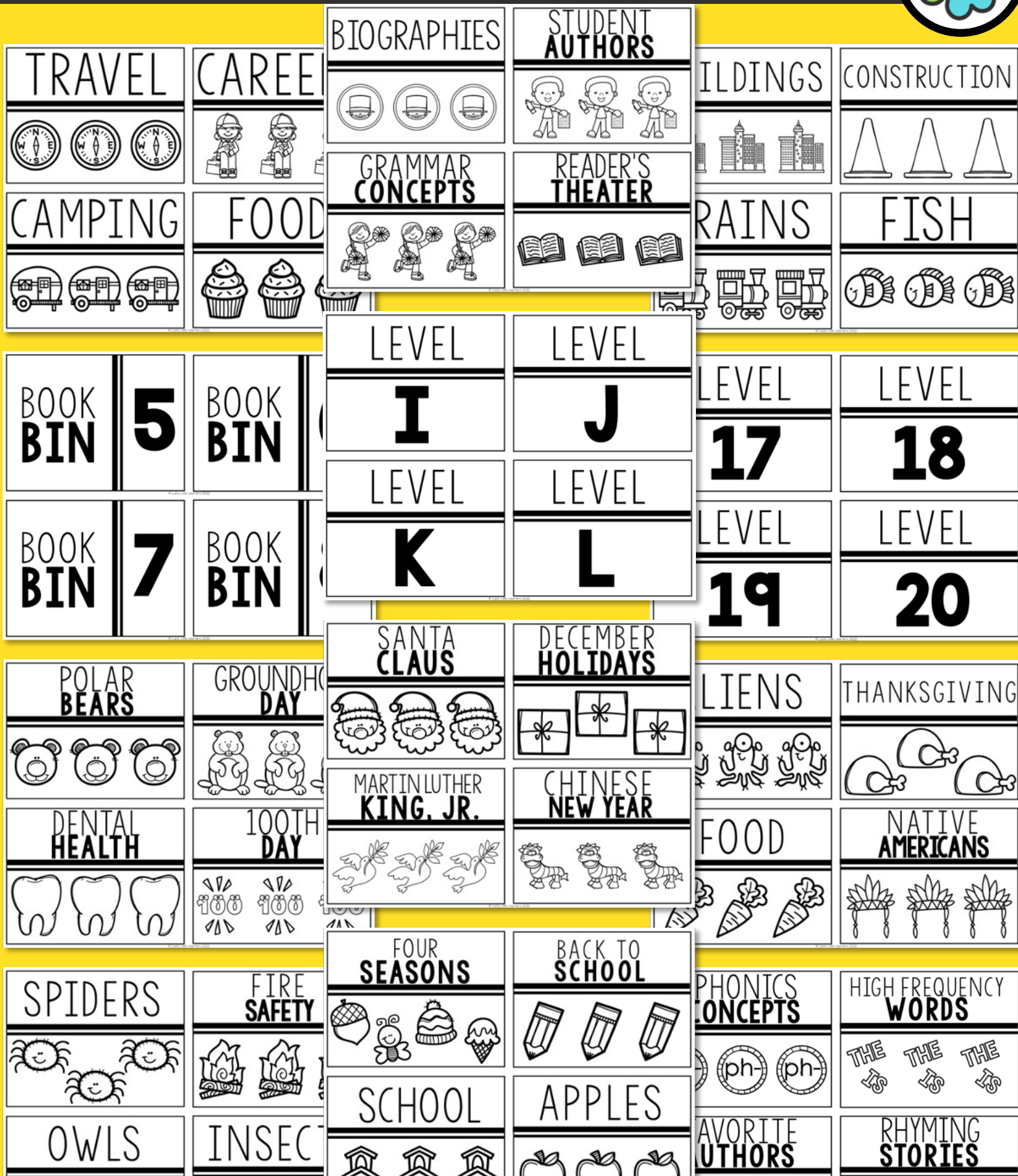

3" x 8" — Ideal for large book bins

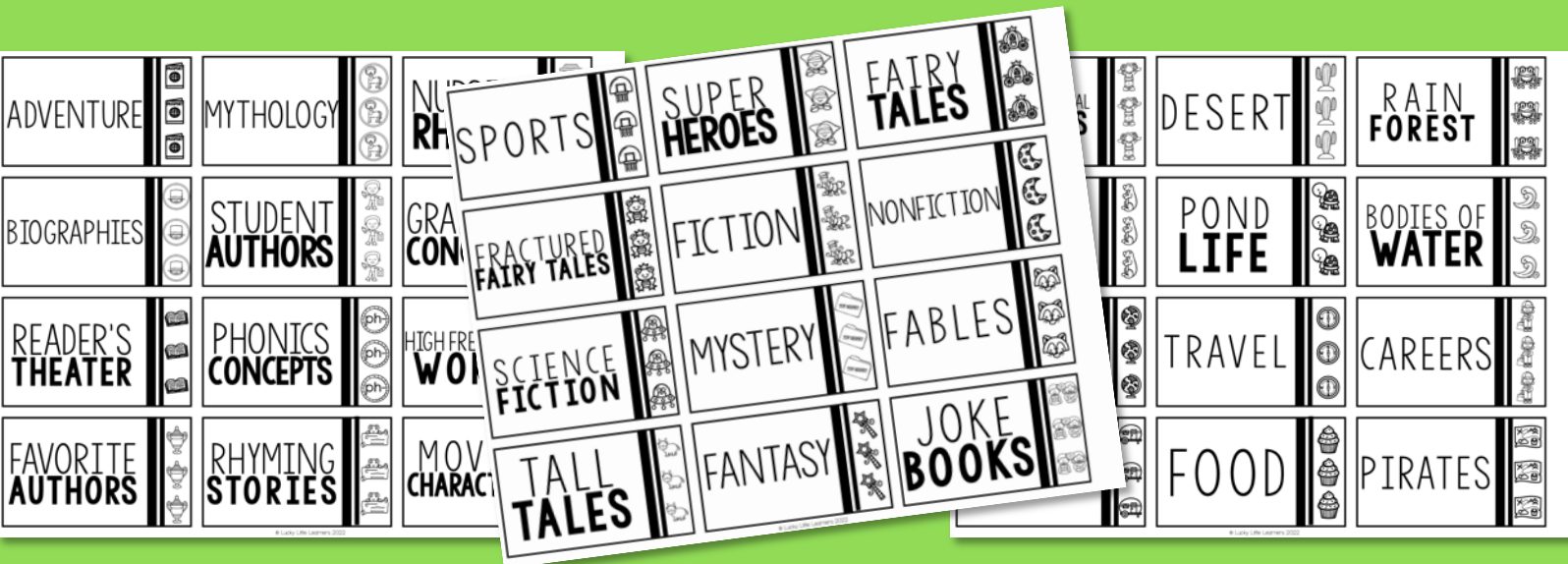
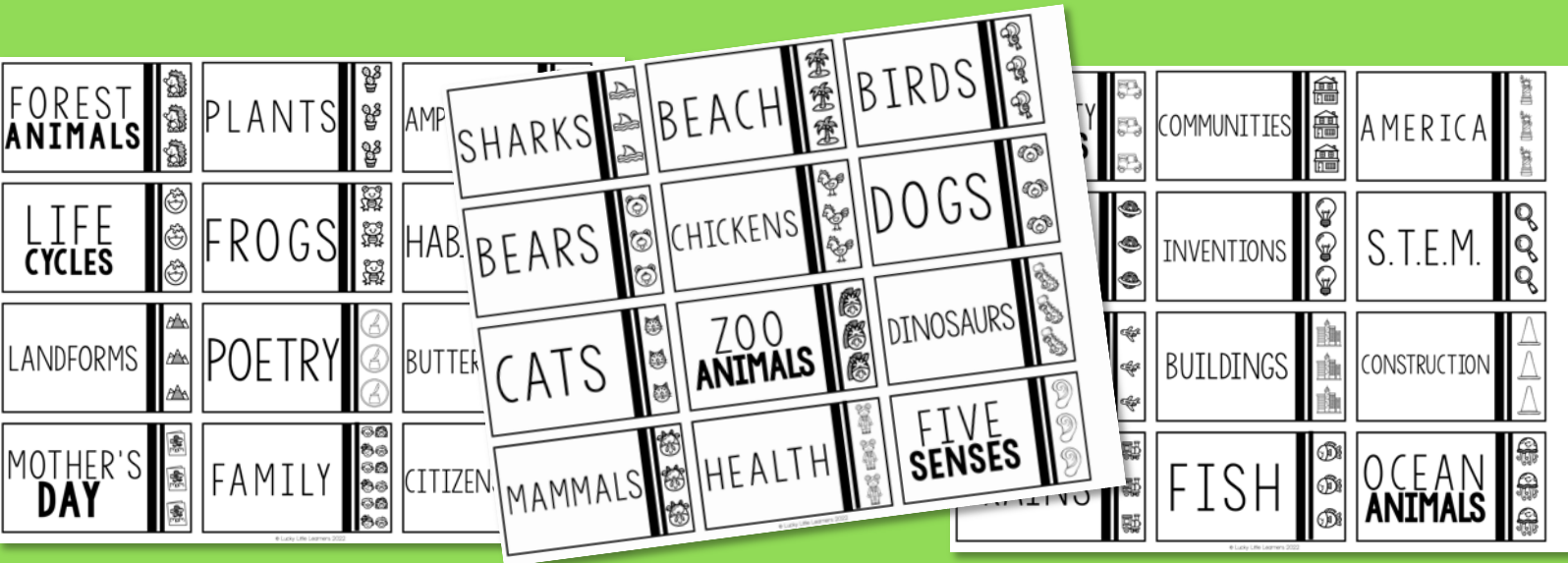


# MEDIUM LABELS
