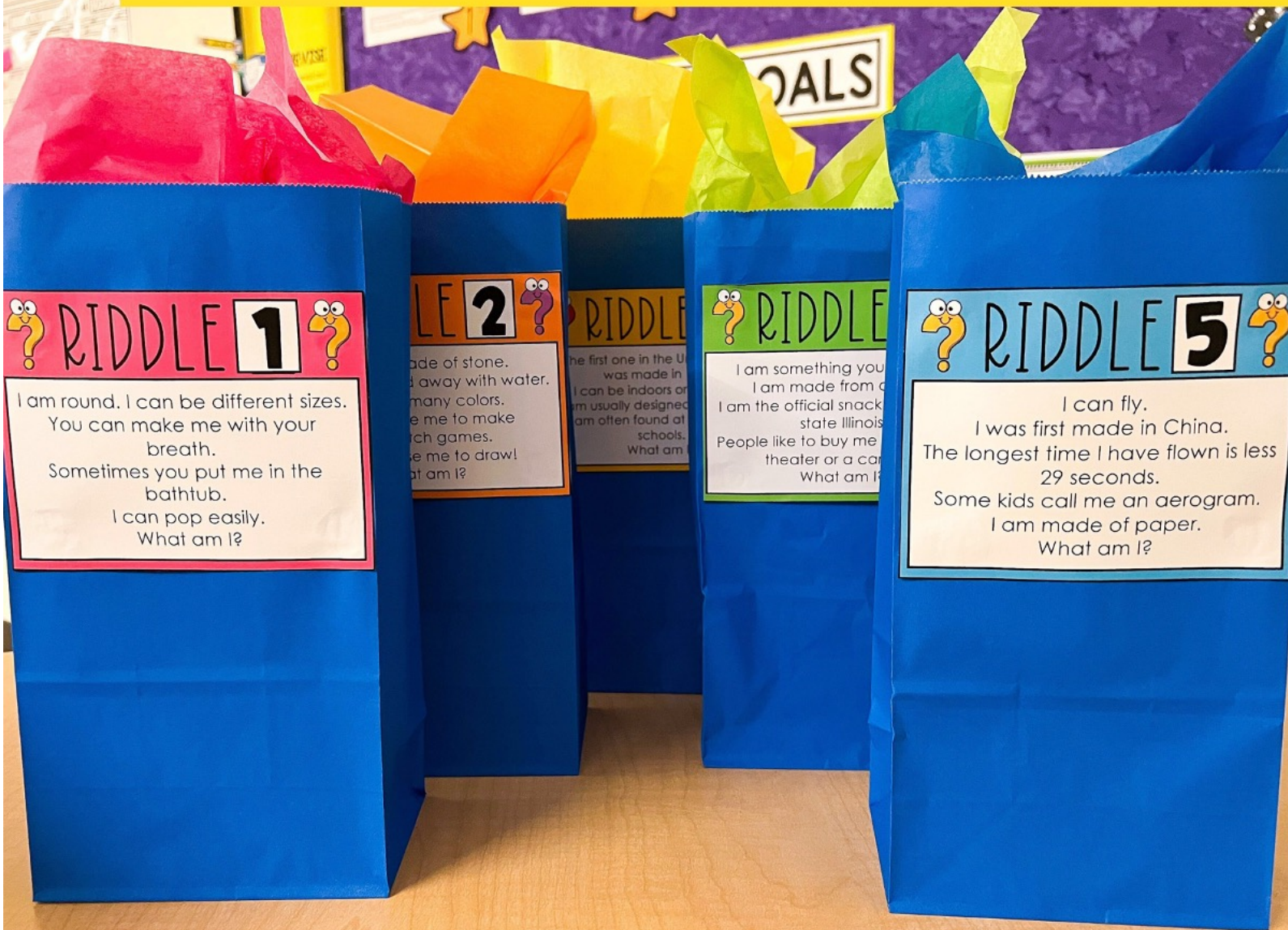

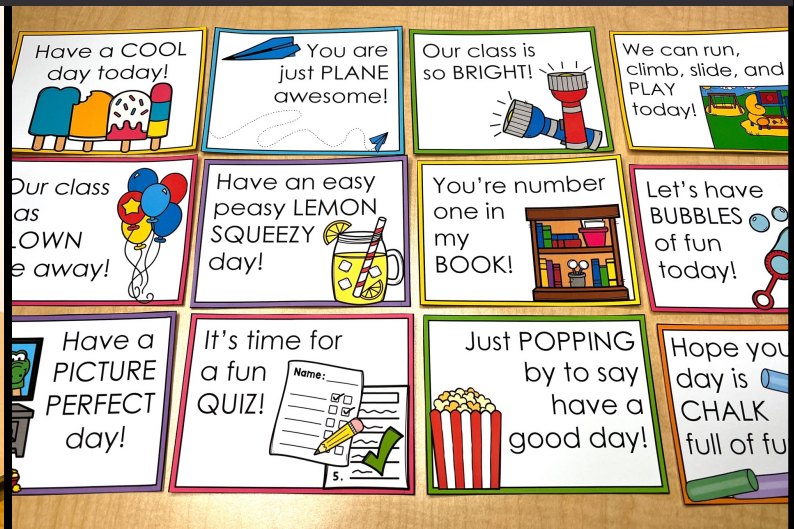

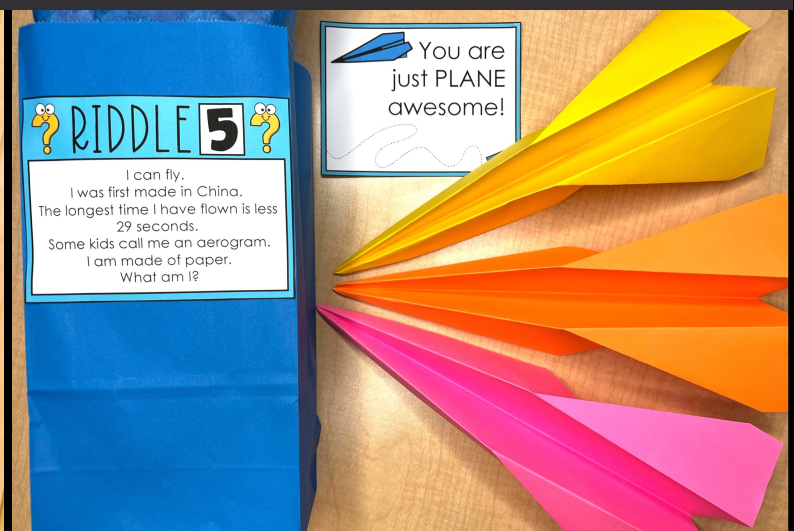

# COUNTDOWN RIDDLE BAGS

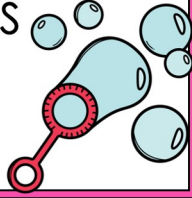
<b>SURPRISE</b>	<b>CLASSROOM IDEAS</b>
Bubbles	Blow bubbles outside, let students chew bubble gum, do experiments.
Sidewalk chalk	Draw with chalk on the pavement or sidewalk, or on black butcher paper or construction paper.
Popsicles	Let students eat popsicles outside for a fun treat.
Kickball	Play kickball against another class.
Paper airplanes	Make paper airplanes and have a competition to see how far they fly.
Movie	Watch a short video or movie.
Quiz	Play Kahoot or Quizziz, or make a fun quiz with facts about class members, or students make quizzes about themselves.
Dance	Do a dance party or learn a dance together.
Playground	Do playground games like monster tag, an obstacle course, hide and seek, or give kids an extra free recess.
Flashlight	Read in the dark with flashlights.
Game	Play board games or math games you've enjoyed this year.
Lemonade	Bring lemonade for students to drink, or make lemonade together.
Balloons	Give students a balloon to decorate with a sharpie and then blow up.
Art	Do an art project such as giving groups a large piece of butcher paper to make a mural.
Books	Give bookmarks or have students design their own, then do a read-a-thon.
Popcorn	Eat popcorn while watching a slideshow of photos from the year.
Candy	Give students a piece of candy, or do a graphing activity with candy.
Pens	Give students a pen to do their work with for the day.
Cookies	Pass out cookies for students to eat while they do their work.
Glow sticks	Turn the lights out and have a glow dance party,

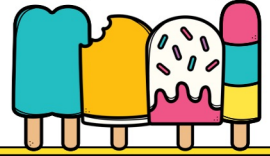

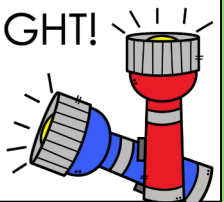

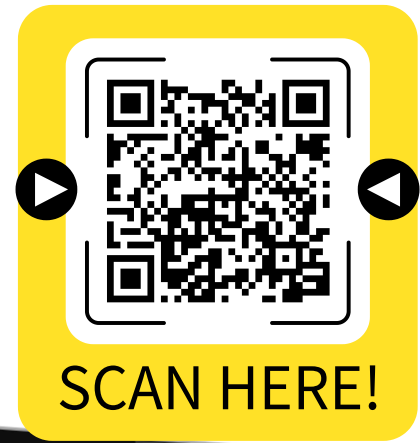
