ECHOLOCATION CHALLENGE

Bats rely on sound to help them find their food and to navigate their way through the night sky. This is called **echolocation**. Bats and other animals that use echolocation emit sound woves that bounce off of things around and in front of them. After sending off the sound waves, they listen for the echo. This tells them how far away the object may be.


Today, you and your classmates will try to use echolocation to tell where something is in the room.

Materials Needed: blindfold (folded fabric, bandana, sentence strip)

Procedures:

- 1. Divide the class into small groups or stay together as one large group
- Choose one person to be the bat. Place the blindfold over their eyes.(Move furniture and other items out of their way so that they are safe.)
- The bat will stand still in the middle of the room. The rest of the partner or class will spread out around the room.
- Choose one person from the group to clap or snap. Everyone else should remain silent. The clap will represent the bat's 'food'.
- The 'bar' will try to use its senses to figure out where the sound was coming from and where their 'food' is. Record your information on your chart.
- Keep choosing new bats and repeat this procedure until everyone has had a chance to be a bat.






