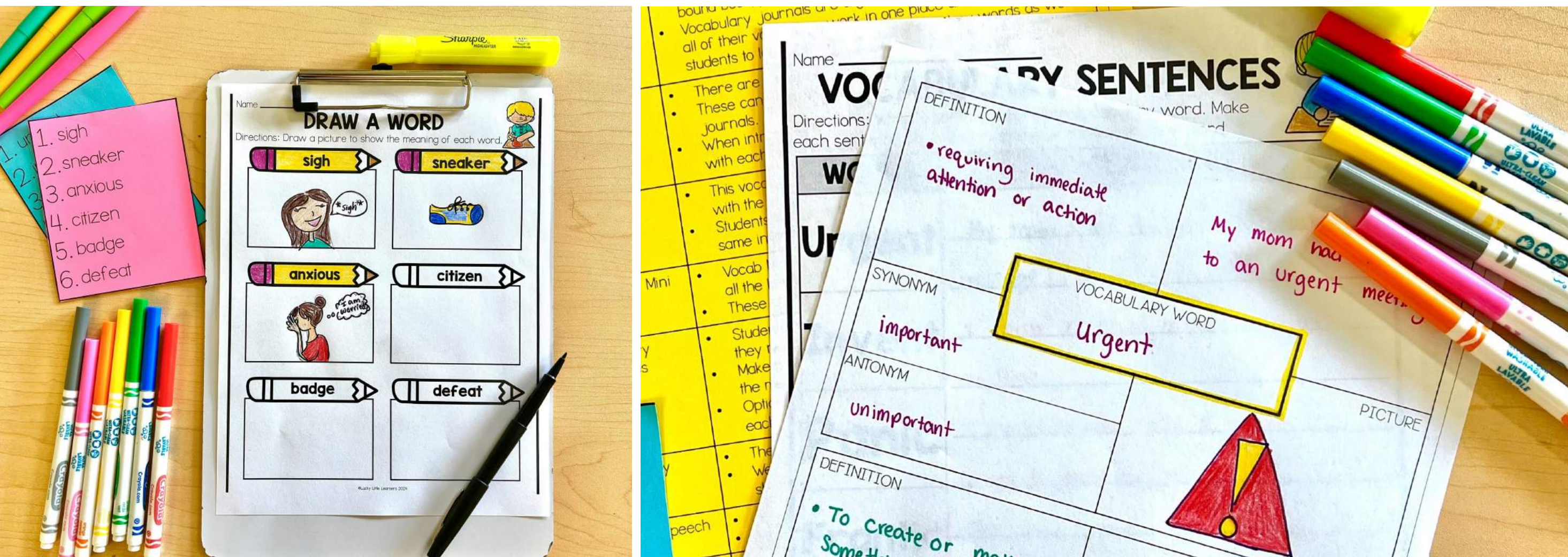

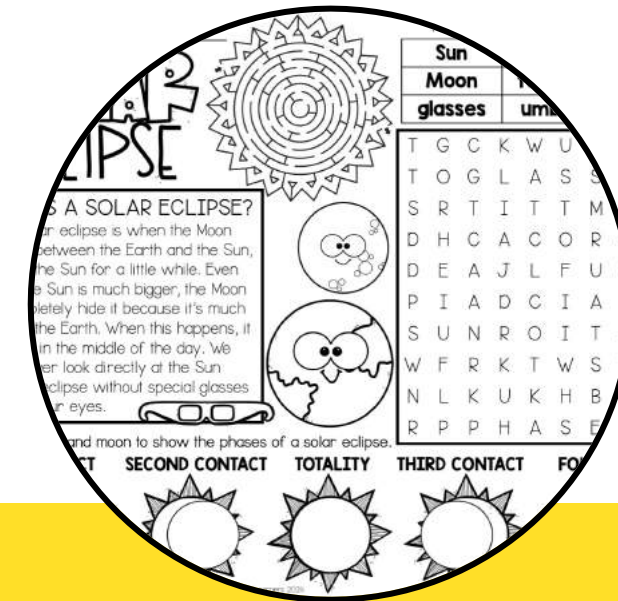
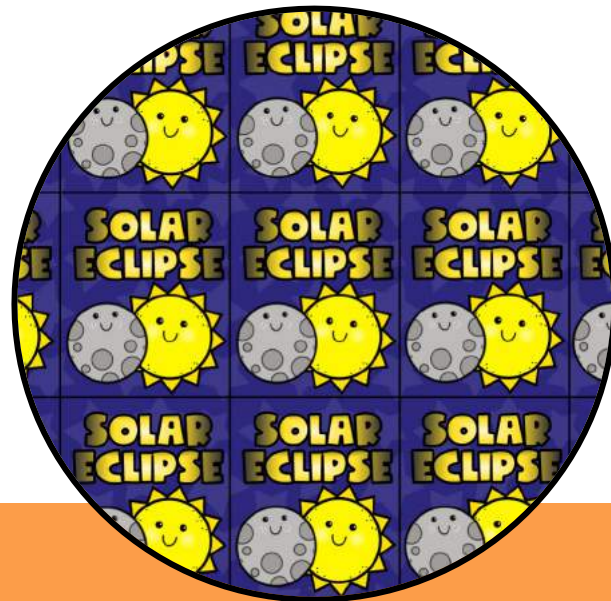

With the AUTOFILL file, you can easily type in the week's words, and they auto populate on the activity pages! Print and go!

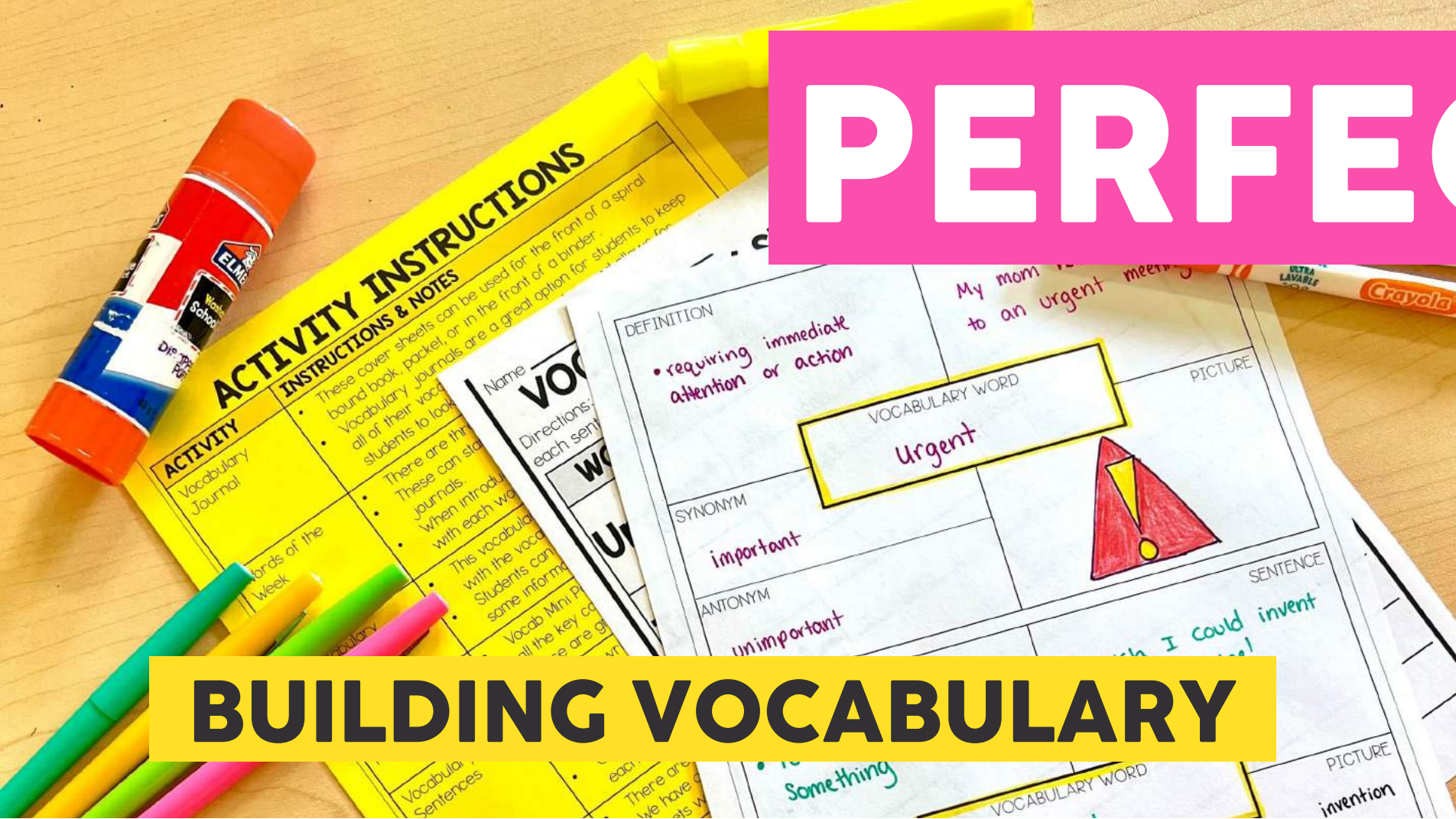

EDITABLE SLIDES

EXPLICIT VOCABULARY ROUTINE

- STEP 1**
 - Pronounce the word.
 - Write it.
 - Read it.
- STEP 2**
 - Tell students what the word means.
 - Keep the definition simple and straightforward.
- STEP 3**
 - Say more about the word (synonyms, antonyms, etc.).
 - Give examples of the word.
- STEP 4**
 - Ask questions about the word's meaning.
 - Students begin using the word in context.
- STEP 5**
 - Elicit word use by students.
 - This is a great time for student presentations of the activities included in this routine.

WEEKLY VOCABULARY ROUTINE

- DAY 1**
 - Use the explicit vocabulary routine to introduce half of the words for the week.
 - Give each word an action.
 - Display the word in the classroom.
- DAY 2**
 - Use the explicit vocabulary routine to introduce the other half of the words for the week.
 - Give each word an action.
 - Display the word in the classroom.
- DAY 4**
 - Choose an activity for students to practice the vocabulary words for the week.
- DAY 5**
 - Choose an activity for students to practice the vocabulary words for the week.
 - Review past vocabulary words.



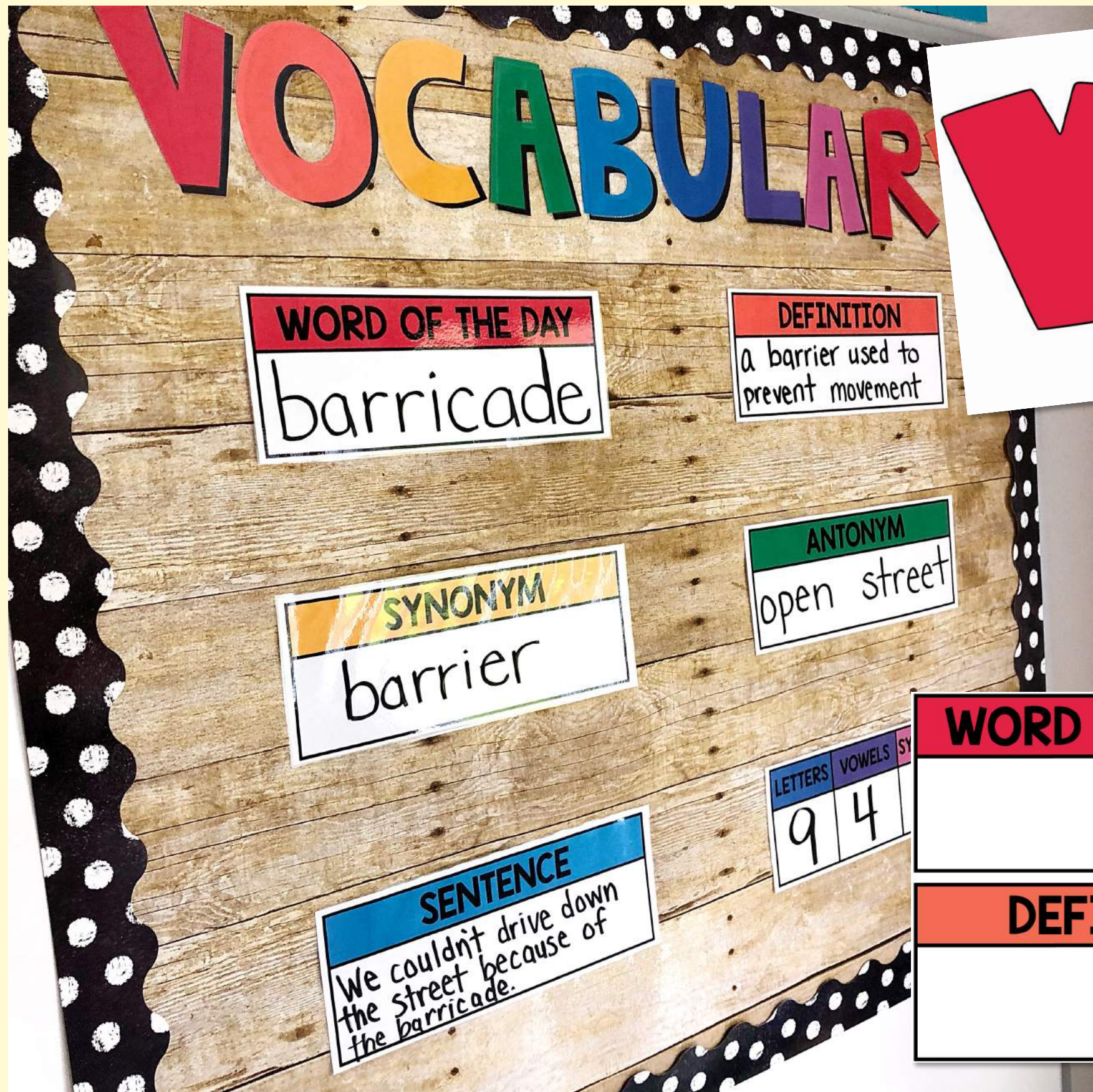

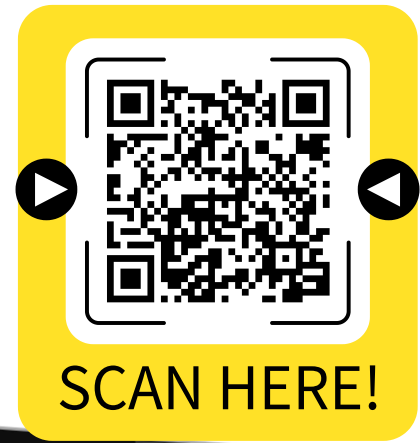
