ARCHERY Archers use a bow and arrow to shoot targets.	ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS	ARTISTIC SWIMMING	ATHLETICS (TRACK & FIELD)
BOXING Boxers wear gloves and fight each other in a ring.	BREAKING Dancers combine athleticism and artistry, also called breakdancing.	CANOE SLALOM Athletes go through hanging gates on a river using a canoe or kayak.	CANOE SPRINT Athletes race in kayaks or canoes on calm water over a short distance.
