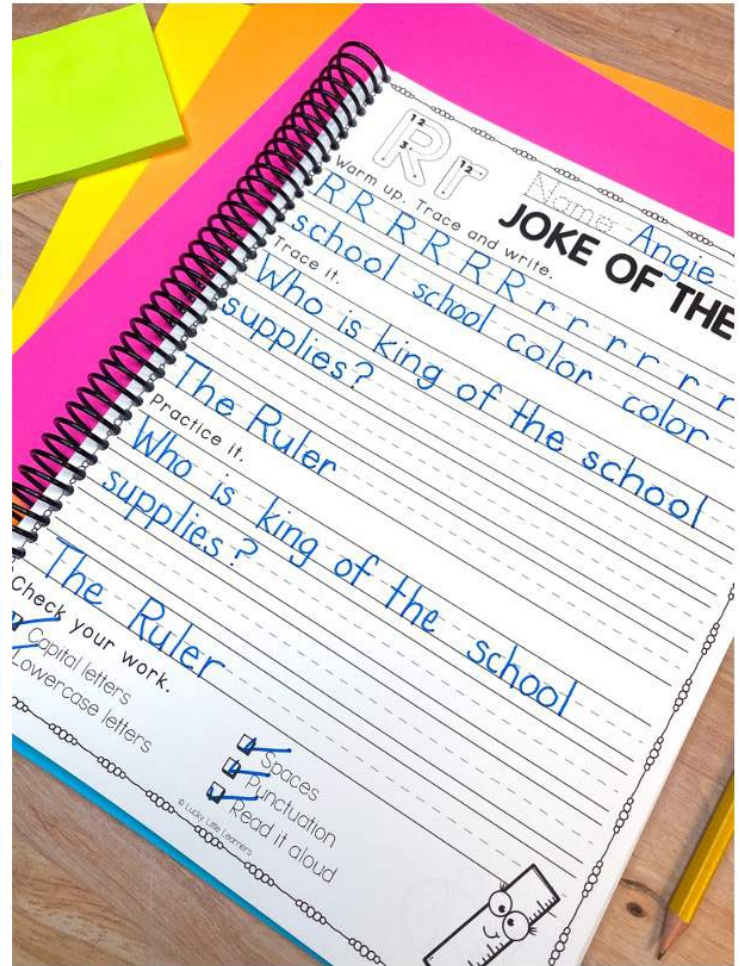
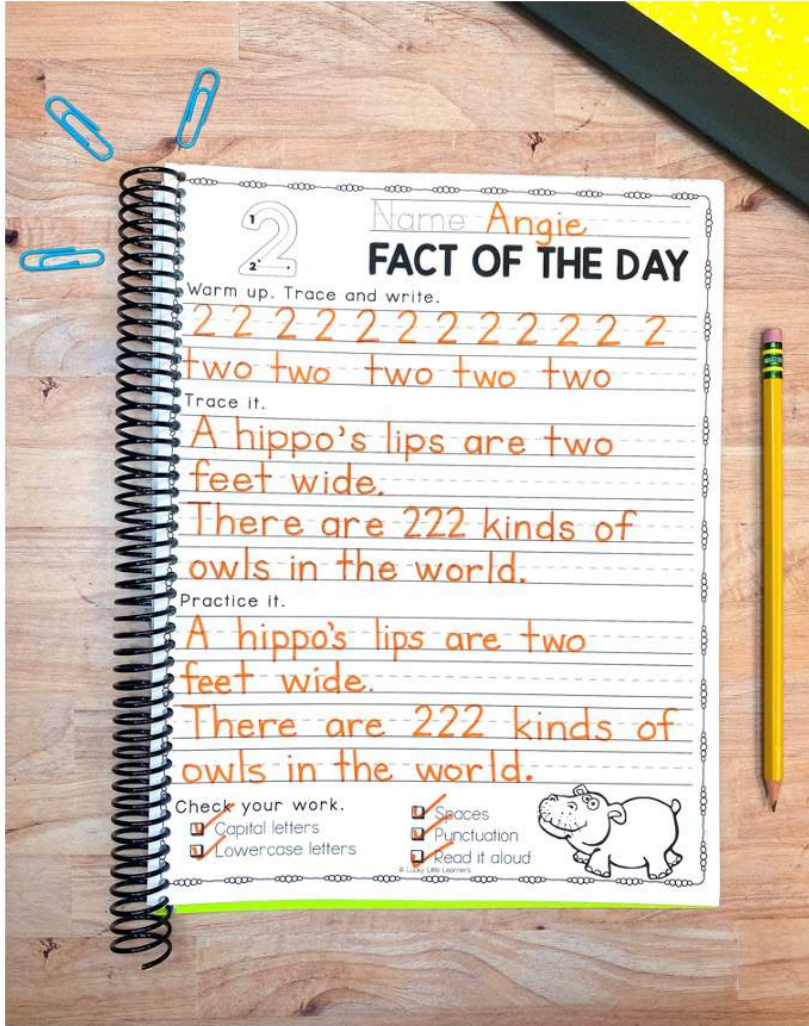

Each page has letters, sight words, and 1-2 jokes or facts to trace and practice! Students build stamina in a non-threatening way.

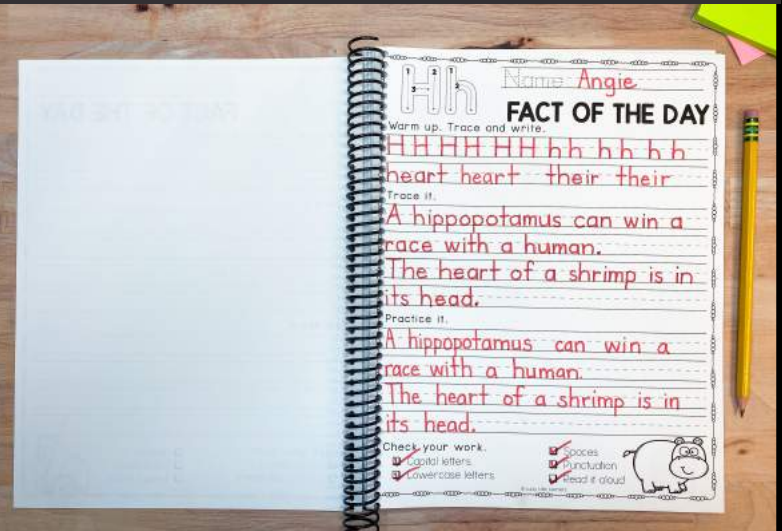
